RE: Annual Asbestos Notification

The Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act of 1986 (referred to as AHERA) requires local educational agencies to inspect their school buildings for asbestos-containing building material, prepare asbestos management plans and perform asbestos response actions to prevent or reduce asbestos hazards.

The notification letter, education and training of our employees, a set of plans and procedures designed to minimize the disturbance of the asbestos containing materials, and plans for regular surveillance of the asbestos-containing materials are a part of our efforts to meet government regulations (AHERA). Our buildings must be completely inspected every three (3) years and then every six months there is a survey that reports any changes to this report.

The Lindenwold District has asbestos materials in all school buildings other than the High School. A copy of the asbestos management plan for each building is available for your inspection in all main offices during regular office hours.
