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ZERO TOLERANCE Infractions	The building principal in accordance with the Student Discipline Conduct Code, will take disciplinary action, and in addition, student bus privileges will be suspended for a period up to five (5) to ten (10) days.	The Principal has authority to suspend for one full month (i.e., up to thirty-one (31) calendar days) for serious disciplinary offenses. Parent conferences required upon return to the school bus. Bus driver may be present.	The building principal, following the Student Discipline Conduct Code, will take disciplinary action, and in addition, bus privileges will be terminated for the remainder of the school year.
