LINDENWOLD SCHOOL COVID DISTRICT PROTOCOLS 2022 - 2023

Universal Masking	Universal masking is no longer a Lindenwold School District requirement. Student masking will be at the discretion of the parent. It will be staff choice if a mask is worn during the work day or at work-related functions. However, students and staff <u>WILL</u> be required to mask when entering the nurse's office.
Masking Following a COVID Positive Test Result	Upon returning to school, a student or staff member must wear a mask on days 6 - 10 following a COVID-19 positive test result or onset of symptoms.
Weekly Testing of Unvaccinated Staff	The Governor has cancelled the Executive Order which required unvaccinated staff to test for COVID on a weekly basis; therefore, the District will <u>no longer</u> test unvaccinated staff.
Universal masking requirement when assigned to a cohort where a district defined "hot spot" has been identified.	If a District defined Covid-19 "hot spot" has been identified by the District nursing and administrative staff, students and staff will be required to mask for days 1 - 10 from the date of the most recent identified COVID positive case.

<p>COVID-19 Close Contact Exposure</p>	<p>Families of students and our staff identified as a "close contact" of an individual who tested positive for COVID will be notified by the school district. Quarantining will no longer be a requirement for the staff member, student, or the student's siblings; <i>however, all close contacts will be required to mask for 10 days following the exposure to the positive individual.</i></p>
<p>Visitors upon arrival to the building</p>	<p>Visitors will sign a standard acknowledgement that affirms the visitor does not currently have symptoms of COVID, has not been in close contact with anyone who has tested positive for COVID-19, and the visitor will agree to report to the school if they receive a COVID positive test in the following <i>48 hours</i>.</p>
<p>Visitors in Classrooms</p>	<p>Social distancing will be required when outside guests visit classrooms for activities such as: class readings, parties, etc.</p>
<p>Visitors on Class Trips</p>	<p>If school trips require chaperones, family chaperones will be permitted. Visitors will sign a standard acknowledgement that affirms the visitor does not currently have symptoms of COVID, has not been in close contact with anyone who has tested positive for COVID-19, and the visitor will agree to report to the school if they receive a COVID positive test in the following <i>48 hours</i>.</p>
<p>Water Fountain Usage</p>	<p>Water fountains will remain "closed" throughout this school year. Bottle filling stations will be provided for each building. Students may bring-in and use a see-through water bottle during the school day.</p>
